

WARRANTY CONDITIONS FOR STREET FURNITURE – Betoni collection

THE NATURAL BEAUTY OF CONCRETE

Betoni products (CLASSIC, SIMPLE and ORGANIC planters; FLORIA GRAND and FLORIA SIMPLE benches) are made of natural concrete material with distinctive features. Each piece is an original – the colour may vary slightly and ganges naturally over time. The surface may contain pores or micro-cracks/hairline cracks that are part of the unique aesthetic expression of concrete. These features do not affect the quality, durability or functionality of the product and shall not be considered a defect in the goods or grounds for a claim.

ADVANTAGES

- High strength and durability
- Aesthetic appearance - modern and elegant design suitable for a variety of architectural styles.
- Environmentally friendly - lower water content and reduced CO₂ emissions compared to conventional concrete

USES

- Outdoor environment: gardens, terraces, park areas, public spaces
- Indoor environment: interiors, o-ces, commercial spaces, apartments.

MECHANICAL RESISTANCE

- Do not use abrasives or harsh sponges.
- Protect the surface from contact with sharp and hard objects (e.g. knives).
- Use protective pads (wooden or plastic) when working.
- Soft metals such as lead, tin or aluminium can leave visible marks.
- Do not overload the products or subject them to impact

HEAT RESISTANCE

The surface treatment can withstand short-term contact with temperatures up to 240 °C, However, we recommend using pads under hot objects and avoiding direct heat.

CHEMICAL RESISTANCE

- The surface is protected by a breathable coating that reduces water absorption and protects the structure of the material.
- Prolonged contact with water (more than 24 hours) can cause the surface to darken - After drying, the appearance is restored.
- Avoid contact with soapy water, cleaners, hydroxides and solvents.
- Short-term contact with acids (e.g. vinegar, wine, juice) is fine, but always wipe clean immediately

RECOMMENDED USES

- Always use protective pads.
- Do not place hot objects directly on the surface.
- Wipe off aggressive substances immediately with a damp cloth.
- not cover outdoor products, even in winter - concrete needs to "breathe".

CLEANING

For cleaning, use a soft cloth or sponge and a common degreasing cleaner.

Do not use: Rough sponges, abrasives, chemical cleaners (thinners, descalers, hydroxides). A damp cloth or alcohol-based cleaner can be used for polishing

REPAIRS AND RENOVATION

Our concrete products are designed with durability and longevity in mind. Concrete is coloured throughout, so minor scratches, abrasions or micro-cracks/ hairline cracks are usually not significantly visible and do not normally require repair. In the case of minor mechanical damage, we recommend not to intervene, as an unprofessional repair can accentuate the problem. The surface of concrete naturally develops a patina as part of its aesthetic development. However, if a fall from a height were to occur, irreversible damage in the form of cracks or deformations may occur which cannot be repaired. NATURAL VARIATIONS

Variations in colour and texture are natural - they are due to differences in the composition of the raw materials and the curing process.

The occurrence of lime efflorescence does not affect the performance and is not considered a defect.
